COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

- Face Covering
 - All clients and any essential visitor they may bring must wear a face covering at all times while on the ground. Riders may put their face covering in their pocket while riding, to be returned to their face before dismounting.

- Equipment
 - Riders must wear gloves while mounting, dismounting and for the duration of their time on the horse. We will have gloves for sale in the office.
 - Crops will NOT be available to borrow but can be purchased at the office.
 - Boots and helmets will not be available to borrow or rent and can be purchased at the office
 - Riders must provide their own certified horseback riding helmet and boots that come above the ankle, zip or lace, and have a one inch heel.
 - Riders are PROHIBITED from riding in sneakers, flat soled shoes, and bike helmets.

- Barn Access
 - At this time, for the safety of all, there will be NO ACCESS to the barn. Horses will be tacked by our staff, brought to and retrieved from the ring for all of our riders at each lesson.
 - Only saddles kept on the property may be utilized on our school horses at this time.

- Spectators & Viewing
 - No guests are allowed on the grounds at this time.
 - Junior riders may bring a parent with them. We ask that all parents and/or drivers remain in the cars or on the deck or patio for the duration of the lesson. All indoor viewing areas will be closed at this point.
 - The office viewing area will be closed until further notice.



- Riders please arrive no earlier than 10 minutes prior to scheduled ride time, and leave directly after finishing. Please do not linger in the office after checking in.
- Social Distancing
 - Please do respect the social distancing guidelines and maintain a distance of six feet (6') from our staff members and each other whenever possible.
- Health Monitoring
 - All employees and essential visitors will have a temperature check upon arrival.
 - If a rider is feeling ill or has been in contact with somebody who has been ill, please contact our office and cancel your lesson.
- Parking
 - We do have a sizable parking lot and will be starting off with primarily private lessons. Please do make use of the space and do not park on top of each other, to give additional social distancing options in the coming warmer days.
- Payment Options
 - All cash and check payments should be placed in our drop box.
 - Please make sure to maintain current and accurate credit card information on file with us.

Your respect and cooperation with these new protocols is greatly appreciated. We will not be able to accommodate lessons for those who are unable to do so. We look forward to being able to ease restrictions as the effects of the pandemic in our area lessen.
